

2016 Christmas Connection

December 1-3, SMBC, in partnership with the Baptist Fellowship Center, provided a Christmas boost for 51 families in the West End of Louisville. Within those 51 families, 161 children will have a merrier Christmas as a result of all that was done on those days.

This year's Christmas Connection effort began back in October as we gathered for a Disney-themed night of music and fun that successfully raised close to \$12,000. During the weeks between the concert and the Christmas Connection event, many were involved in the extensive preparations. Gifts and blankets were bought, uniforms and Bibles were ordered, and gift bags were prepared. The game room at our church looked like a storage room for Santa's toy shop.

On Thursday, December 1, 19 individuals loaded the truck, transported the goodies to New Zion Baptist Church, and organized the tables. On Friday, December 2, 14 from our church spent the morning wrapping presents.

Then came the big day! Saturday, December 3, we had 66 individuals from SMBC combined with a couple dozen from New Zion Baptist who helped the families select the toys and collect their blanket, Bible and uniforms. Children, youth, and adults all joined together to make the morning run smoothly. After such a big effort to make the Christmas of so many better, all that can be said is thank you! Thank you for giving your money, donating your time, offering up your prayers, and lending your services!

While we might never know the full impact of this ministry, we do know that there were lots of smiles and lots of conversations both between those giving and those receiving as well as those giving from our church and from New Zion Baptist. Connections were made this Christmas because of each one who gave of themselves so freely. If you missed out this year, there's always next.


