Together we build the kingdom! The model is very similar to the one practiced by Upward Sports. The goal is to help local churches connect with children and families that may never have the opportunity to attend a church camp. This summer, 17-20,000 kids will attend WinShape camps being held at 72 locations across the nation . . . including Louisville!

Our friends and ministry colleagues at Westport Road Baptist Church will host a WinShape Camp July 29-August 2, and they need our help. (Remember, it's not about building our church—it's about building the kingdom!) The goal is to have 400 kids in attendance, 200 of which will be on full scholarships. WinShape will provide trained college-age kids to lead the camp, but additional volunteers (age 16 and older) are needed to help. Volunteers are also needed to help with meals, snacks and hospitality. A Registered Nurse is needed every day. Scholarships (each at \$189) are also needed.






Lynch Mission Trip

On May 16-18, a group of volunteers from St. Matthews Baptist Church traveled to Lynch, Kentucky, for a short term mission trip. The trip involved two mission components, a dental clinic and a community work project. The team working in the dental clinic consisted of two dentists, four dental hygienists, three dental students from the University of Louisville, two nurses and several laypersons. As in years past, the dental clinic was set up in the Community Christian Church. More than sixty patients were seen for dental exams, cleanings, and extractions during the two days that the clinic was open. In this economically depressed area, these services were direly needed and very much appreciated by those who received treatment.
