


# **Churchwide Christmas Dinner**

The theme for our Christmas Banquet this year is "One Starry Night" and will take place on Sunday, December 14, 2014. The program this year will involve several musical groups and our Preschool annual Nativity scene. The program will begin at 5:30 pm in the Sanctuary. Seating for dinner in Fellowship Hall and the Gymnasium will begin around 6:00 pm, followed by prayer and dinner at 6:30 pm. The ministers will be stationed along the pathway to the dining halls to greet you along the way. Also new this year will be some photo opportunities in the Foyer and Atrium.
